

# SHOE COVER DISPENSER

# INSTRUCTIONS

– PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS –

Thank you for purchasing the Grower's Edge® Shoe Cover Dispenser. This product is designed to dispense shoe covers to help keep areas free from tracked in contaminants. It's operation is entirely mechanical (no batteries or power source required), providing hands-free application of shoe covers without having to sit, bend over or put down loads that are being carried. Shoe covers come in "packs" with small T-shaped rows of tabs in each corner. These tabs slide into the 4 vertical T-clip holders at each corner of the dispenser. To load shoe covers, follow the 6 steps shown below:



## LOAD SHOE COVERS



Remove top cover. Unroll a pack of shoe covers, making sure the length and width are oriented in the right direction. Slide a row of T-clips down into the T-opening in one corner of the dispenser.



On the diagonally opposite side of the pack, slide another row of T-clips down into the T-opening across from the first one you installed. Repeat to install the remaining 2 rows of T-clips.



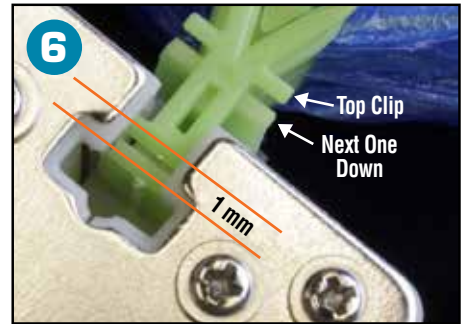
Remove the twist ties that are holding the rows of T-clips together. Dispenser will not operate properly until these are removed!



If you're loading more than 1 pack of shoe covers, push each row of T-clips down on all 4 corners of the previously installed covers to make room for more.



After all pack(s) of shoe covers have been installed, press and smooth them neatly against the sides and bottom of the body.



Adjust the top T-clips in all 4 corners so they're slightly offset toward the center of the dispenser (about 1 mm). Replace top cover. Dispenser is now ready to use.

**TO USE SHOE COVER DISPENSER:** Carefully place one foot into the dispenser, keeping your weight on the opposite leg. Firmly press foot down into dispenser until shoe cover snaps into place. Repeat with opposite foot.

- Never "stomp" feet into the dispenser to install shoe covers. If they are installed correctly, a firm, gentle pressure is all you need on the Step Trigger.
- Remember to hold lower row of tabs down when installing more than 1 pack of shoe covers (review Step 4).
- No matter how many packs of shoe covers are installed, the very top T-clips in each corner must be "offset" slightly for smooth release of cover onto the shoe (review Step 6).
